



Recycling

All metal and wooden parts can be separated and delivered to a suitable recycling station.






Disassembly


1. Screw the 4x4 screws counterclockwise to loosen the wheels from the frame.



2. Remove the wheels. Separate the rubber and steel by cutting the metal pin that holds the wheel in place with pliers.



3. Unscrew the four screws.



4. Remove the wooden plate.
