Material
Walnut and beech veneer, powder-coated steel tubing and steel rod, foam. This product has not been treated with any biocides.

Production process
The steel frame is CNC bent, welded together and powder-coated. The back is made from layers of walnut and beech veneer which are form-pressed and cut to shape using a CNC machine. The seat is made from layers of beech veneer glued together and upholstered foam.






5 YEAR WARRANTY


DISASSEMBLY



1. Remove the upholstery pad by pulling the bottom edge away from the backrest with two hands. The upholstery pad should come loose from the three hooks in the top and the two connectors at the bottom.



2. To disassemble the upholstery pad remove the nails on the backside that secure the fabric to the wood with a flat-headed screwdriver. The foam can be removed by gently pulling.




3. Unscrew the brass caps on the armrests to access the screws.




DISASSEMBLY



4. Remove x3 screws with an Allen key to loosen the backrest.



5. After removing the backrest from the base, the x3 rubber O-rings can be removed.



6. Remove the screws from the base of the chair to separate the seat plate from the frame.
